



# Don't Let Your Guard Down Yet.



## Food Processing

Employers are required to protect their workers from COVID-19 by:

- Implementing an effective social distancing plan in the workplace, providing six feet of space in between workers;
- Ensuring frequent and adequate hand washing;
- Increasing the cleaning and sanitizing of commonly touched surfaces
- Providing education to workers about coronavirus and how to prevent transmission in the *language they understand*;
- Isolating sick workers by making sure sick employees stay home or go home; and
- Establishing procedures for reporting a suspected or confirmed case.

Food processing facilities and workers can take these steps:

- Use partitions installed along the production line to achieve physical distance where social distancing is not possible;
- Wash your hands with soap and water or alcohol-based hand rubs containing at least 60% alcohol;
- Limit the number of workers in shared living quarters or onboard vessels; and
- Avoid group gatherings during breaks, whether onsite in a facility or onshore/offshore
